HANDLING & STORAGE:

- Keep closure end up.

Inhalation: If affected remove to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration and get medical attention immediately. If breathing difficulty persists, get medical attention.

Skin: Remove contaminated clothing; wash affected area with water for at least 15 minutes. Seek medical attention. DO NOT attempt to neutralize with chemical agents. Launder contaminated clothing before reuse.

Eyes: Remove contact lenses. Immediately flush eyes with clear running water for 15 minutes while holding eyelids open. Do not use chemical antidote. Get medical attention immediately.

Ingestion: Drink large quantities of water or milk; DO NOT induce vomiting; seek medical attention. NEVER give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
