**Directions:** Dilute 8oz. per bucket of water.

**LIGHT CLEANING: Using 1 Mop and 1 Bucket**

Put clean mop in bucket of Heavy Duty Degreaser Solution. Ring out as dry as possible. With the well wrung out mop, clean about a 10' X 10' area.

**HEAVY CLEANING: Using 2 Mops and 2 Buckets**

- 1) Put clean mop in bucket of Heavy Duty Degreaser Solution. Do not ring out, with dripping wet mop clean about a 10' X 10' area with the Heavy Duty Degreaser Solution.
- 2) Put the second clean mop in the rinse water bucket, ring it out as dry as possible and pick up the Heavy Duty Degreaser Solution that was just applied to the floor.

**NOTE:** Deck brush as needed, however at least twice a week is recommended on kitchen floors.

**SPRAY CLEANING:** Spray or wipe on, scrub well with cloth or pad, wipe or rinse off as required.

**PARKING LOT STALLS / DRIVE THRU MENU BOARD (OIL SPILL AREAS):**

- Use Heavy Duty Degreaser straight from the gallon bottle directly onto the oil spill to be cleaned.
- Scrub well with the deck brush, and let it soak for about 5 minutes.
- Scrub again with the same deck brush.
- Hose off clean with water.
- Repeat if necessary on areas with heavy build up of oil, dirt and grease.

**NOTE:** Do not use undiluted on composition floors or water base painted surfaces.
