

Directions:

- Simply spray, sprinkle, pour or swab onto the surface to be deiced.
- On glazed ice, scoring the melting surface will help prevent run-off and speed melting.
- However, this liquid ice and snow melt can become diluted as it works and re-application may become necessary.

CAUTION:

- High concentrations are irritating to the respiratory tract; may cause headache, dizziness, nausea, vomiting and malaise. Contact with skin may cause slight irritation; prolonged contact may cause moderate reddening, swelling and possible necrosis. Contact with eyes will cause severe irritation and pain associated with redness and swelling of conjunctiva. If ingested may cause headache, dizziness, diarrhea and general weakness; large doses may result in red blood cell hemolysis.

Inhalation: None Expected. Remove affected person to fresh air; if symptoms persist seek medical attention.

Eyes: Check for and remove contact lenses. Flush eyes with clear running water for 15 minutes while holding eyelids open; if irritation persists, seek medical attention.

Ingestion: Give two glasses of water for dilution; DO NOT induce vomiting; never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person; seek medical attention.
